I am directed to refer to the Ministry's letter dated 15.01.2021 (copy attached) and to say that information regarding marks required for qualifying NEET-2020 as per the revised percentile criteria has been received from National Testing Agency (NTA) and the marks range and number of candidates qualified in each category (General/ EWS/SC/ST/ OBC and PwD of General/EWS SC/ST/ OBC) as per the Qualifying Criteria (Earlier and Revised) are as follows:

Sub: Admission in Under Graduate Courses in ASU&H College for academic session 2020-21-reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer subject cited above and to say that the Ministry has received various representation requesting to reduce the required percentile criteria in the NEET-2020 in order to be eligible for admission in Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathy (ASU & H) UG courses, due to various reasons.


2. In this regard, the matter has been examined by the Ministry and decided that in order to be eligible for admission in ASU & H UG courses, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum marks at 40th percentile in NEET-2020.

However, in respect of candidates belonging to the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 30th percentile. In respect of candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, the minimum marks shall be at 35th percentile for Un-Reserved (UR) Category and 30th percentile for SC/ST/OBC.

3. This clarification is applicable only for academic year 2020-21.
